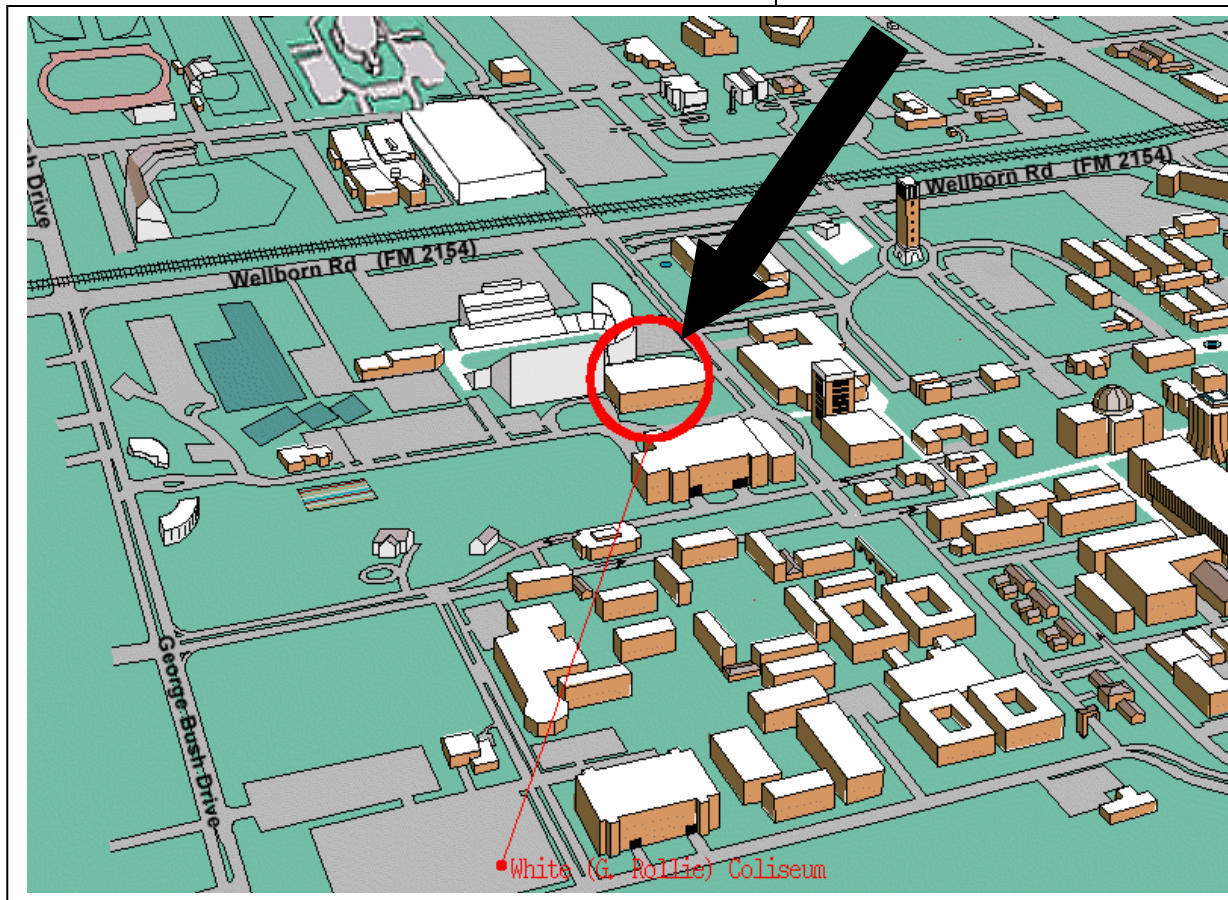

ELIGIBILITY

- 1) A student athlete at a four-year institution may have five (5) consecutive years from the time of first matriculation in which to complete four (4) years of eligibility.
- 2) A student athlete at a two-year institution may have three (3) consecutive years from the time of first matriculation in which to complete two (2) years of eligibility.
- 3) A student athlete who has competed for a college team during the academic year is considered to have used up one year of eligibility.
- 4) A student athlete enrolled in a graduate or post-baccalaureate program may compete in the championships if he/she has not exceeded the four (4) years of eligibility in five (5) years of enrollment rule.

1. Acknowledge that I am familiar with the sport of Judo and understand the rules governing the sport of Judo.
2. Agree that prior to participating, I will inspect the mats, equipment facilities, competition pools or divisions and the elimination or scoring system to be used, and if I believe anything is unsafe or beyond my capability, I will immediately advise my coach, supervisor, and/or a tournament official of such conditions and refuse to participate.

Acknowledge and fully understand that I will be engaging in a contact sport that might result in serious injury, including permanent disability or death, and severe social and economic losses due to not only my own actions, inactions, or negligence, but also to the actions, inactions, or negligence of others, the rules of the sport of Judo, or conditions of the premises or of any equipment used. 4. Knowing the risks involved in the sport of Judo, I assume all such risks and accept personal responsibility for the damages following such injury, permanent disability, or death.
